Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated 29.01.2021 wherein conditional warrants for recovery of Rs.2,21,000/- has been issued against the petitioner.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner candidly submits that petitioner is ready to pay Rs.1.00 lakh out of the outstanding amount to the respondent within 15 days from today. He further submits that he is ready to settle the dispute amicably with the wife and for that purpose, this matter deserves to be referred to the mediation as well.

Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to deposit/pay the amount of Rs.1.00 lakh, as per the undertaking given by him, within 15 days from today. If he deposits the said amount and files an

the SDJM, Sri Anandpur Sahib, within the stipulated period, the conditional warrants issued against him would be deferred and the Family Court would take into consideration his further prayer regarding settling the dispute amicably as well. The said Court is free to decide the manner and reasonable time period to be granted to the petitioner for the payment of the remaining amount to the respondent.

Needless to say that if the above undertaking given is not honoured by the petitioner, this order would automatically stands vacated.
