Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners had filed a writ petition being CWP No.1587 of 2022 seeking certain benefits and during the pendency of the said writ petition, the benefits were given to the petitioners but now vide order dated 13.10.2022, the said benefits are being withdrawn and the recovery has been effected from the petitioner.

On being pointed out, whether the earlier writ petition is pending or not, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the earlier writ petition claiming the benefits which are now sought to be withdrawn, is still pending consideration. Hence, appropriate remedy before the petitioner was to file appropriate application in the said petition or to amend the same rather than filing the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file appropriate application in CWP No.1587 of 2022 either to amend or for any interim order, which the petitioner is seeking in the present petition.
