This petition has been filed by complainant under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to produce the action taken status report regarding FIR No.060 dated 13.06.2021, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur (Section 326 IPC added later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that despite having registered the FIR approximately six months back, no action is being taken by the police to arrest the accused. According to him, the offences are serious and subsequently, the offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was also added. Through this petition, he has prayed for directions to official respondents to produce the action taken report.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh, has stated that in all, there are four accused i.e. respondent Nos.4 to 7 and accused Balwinder Singh and Baljinder Singh (respondent Nos.6 and 7) have been granted the concession of interim pre arrest bail,

whereas the continuous efforts are being made to arrest the other accused persons, namely, Bachiter Singh and Pardeep Kaur (respondent Nos.4 and 5).

Considering the above background and the fact that the police is taking steps to arrest the accused, no case is made out for exercise of inherent powers at this stage.

Dismissed.
