Complaining wilful violation of the order dated 11th November, 2020 passed in CWP-19056-2020, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The relevant extract of the order dated 11th November, 2020 is extracted as under:-

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case and the entitlement as such of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed off with the direction to respondents No.2 and 3 / competent authority to decide the legal notice dated 23.08.2019 (Annexure P - 6 of the petitioner within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, the said claims are found admissible, the amounts be paid thereafter within a period of 2 months. In case, the relief is not admissible and the amount is not liable to be paid, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner forthwith.

Disposed off."

Sh. Nikhil Chopra, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, on instruction from Shri Hanish Garg, Clerk, has submitted that the payment has already been deposited in the account of the petitioner.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that a speaking order has not been passed.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the speaking order was passed on 3rd February, 2021. He undertakes to supply a copy of the speaking order to the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid, no further order is required to be passed.
