Prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for release of the petitioner on parole for the marriage of his daughter, which is stated to be fixed for 24.01.2022.

It is not disputed that the petitioner is already on parole and he has to surrender on 18.01.2022. In pursuance to the order dated 05.01.2022, the State has filed its reply through affidavit of Mr. Satyabhan, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Gurugram, wherein the stand taken is that the applicant has not been submitted any application for granting parole and there is no provision for extension of parole. His case for parole for his daughter's marriage would be considered on the same day when the petitioner surrenders.

It is, however, admitted that the marriage is fixed for 24.01.2022, which has been duly verified through the police authorities, in

view of the order passed by this Court. An order dated 10.01.2022 has been passed by the Superintendent of Prison, District Prison, Gurugram, denying extension of parole, in view of the stand as such taken. The same is placed on record as Annexure R-4.

Accordingly, keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances, since the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 24.01.2022, the importance of the petitioner in the family as such to be present on the said date cannot be lost sight off, as he has to perform the ceremony of *Kanayadan*.

Resultantly, the present petition is disposed with the directions that the period of parole of the petitioner shall stand extended till 30.01.2022. He shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on 31.01.2022 at 10:00 AM.
