Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.7 dated 2.11.2021 under Sections 498-A, 323 IPC registered at Women Police Station Malerkotla, District Malerkotla.

By virtue of the order dated 23.12.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated, hence, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.12.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
