The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.104 dated 04.08.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 506 IPC at Police Station Panjokhara, district Ambala, on the basis of a written compromise dated 17.12.2021 (Annexure P-3).

On 05.01.2022, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 20.01.2022 for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise between the parties.

As directed, report dated 24.01.2022 from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala has been received, as per which the parties had

recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR, in which the offences are not heinous and the matter is having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052***, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No.104 dated 04.08.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 506 IPC at Police Station Panjokhara, district Ambala and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.
