Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.86 dated 06.11.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Women Police Station, Patiala, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 28.12.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 28.12.2021, petitioner has already joined the investigation. He submits that petitioner is in BSF and is posted in Tripura at present. He further submits that on the earlier occasions, he appeared physically before the Mediation Centre, however, the matter

could not be settled at that stage.

The report of the Mediator dated 28.02.2022 also affirms the same that despite best efforts, no fruitful results could be achieved.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sanjeev Kumar, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the facts and circumstances, I find that the case deserves to be investigated thoroughly and decided on merits. Accordingly, interim order dated 28.12.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
