The petitioner is seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to grant seniority and other consequential benefits as he had been appointed on the same date as one-Manish Khanna.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has sent a legal notice dated 29.09.2021 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.1 and states that the petition may be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

Two sets of the petition be furnished to learned counsel for the respondents in the course of the day.

Without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioner (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
