The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the parole to the petitioner for eight weeks for meeting with his family members.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the present petition on the ground that the jurisdiction of this Court qua parole is only restricted to arbitrariness or unreasonable, which is not existing.

After arguing for some time, petitioner's counsel submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh representation for parole and concerned Superintendent of Jail be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner.

The prayer is genuine.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty to the petitioner to file fresh application for parole before the concerned Superintendent of Jail, who shall decide the same within two weeks days from the date of its filing.
