Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.26 dated 21.08.2019 registered under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, however, Section 406 IPC was added later on, at Police Station Women Cell, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

FIR (Annexure P-1) is an outcome of matrimonial dispute and vide order dated 04.10.2019, petitioner, who is the husband of complainant-respondent No.2 was granted interim bail by this Court and was directed to join investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the

petition, parties have entered into a compromise dated 31.05.2022 and a separate petition (CRM-M-32874 of 2022) has been instituted seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Upon instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, Sate counsel submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and no recovery has been effected from him.

Keeping in view the fact that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled, but without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed and the order dated 04.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
