In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that the petitioners be granted the benefit of 1st and 2nd ACP from the date they become eligible keeping in view the ACP Rules, 2016.

Petitioners have mentioned in the writ petition that they were eligible for the grant of benefit of ACP but the same was not granted to them and that too without any valid justification and though the petitioners had approached the respondents raising the said grievance but the benefit has not been extended to them and that too without any valid justification.

From the pleadings, it transpires that for the relief, which has been sought in the present writ petition, petitioners have submitted a legal notice dated 20.06.2022 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioners in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/legal notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 20.06.2022 (Annexure P-7) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to them within a period of next four weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
