The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint No.COMI/245/2018 dated 14.05.2018, under Sections 506, 467, 468, 470, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant submits that in pursuance to the compromise/settlement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the petitioners had handed over two cheques for the total amount of Rs.1.20 crore to learned counsel for respondent No.2, which was recorded in order dated 19.12.2019 passed by this Court. Another Demand Draft dated 20.01.2020, amounted to Rs.60 lakhs was handed over to the counsel for respondent No.2 which is recorded in order dated 21.01.2020. Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant submits that he has instructions to

state that his client is satisfied with the receipt of the amount and in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the aforesaid statement and the orders passed by this Court, this petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to get the matter revived, in case any cause of actions still survives.
