Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 9 dated 18.1.2020, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

There was recovery of 3400 tablets of Cloxidol-100SR and 600 tablets of Prazolam from the petitioner.

One of the ground for seeking bail is that the petitioner is in custody since 18.1.2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that out of total seven prosecution witnesses, five have been examined and the next date fixed before the trial Court is 18.2.2022. He further on instructions submits that the prosecution evidence would be concluded within two months from the date fixed.

In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

No doubt, in case a request is made before the trial Court for accommodating dates for an early conclusion of prosecution evidence, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
