In compliance of the last order dated 28.10.2022 passed by this Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Singh, Inspector, In charge, NRI Cell, Amritsar, is present in Court. He has informed the Court that he talked to the alleged detainee, namely, Deha Angel on Mobile No.7888551519, who has stated that she is staying happily with Saurav Sharma-respondent No.5 and has gone out of her own free will.

In view of the above, Mr. Kamalpreet Singh, Inspector, In charge, NRI Cell, Amritsar, is directed to inform respondents No.5 to 8 in writing with regard to the pendency of the instant petition before this Court. Apart from this, dasti process is also issued for the service of respondents No.5 to 8.

Respondents No.5 to 8 are directed to produce the alleged detainee, namely, Deha Angel before this Court on the adjourned date.

During pre-lunch session, this Court had passed the aforementioned order. However, before signing of the said order, during post lunch session, a request has been made by the learned counsel for both the parties that the alleged detainee, namely, Deha Angel, is present in Court and is willing to make her statement. Mr. Nandan Jindal, Advocate, who is present in Court, has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.5- Saurav Sharma and has also filed memo of appearance on behalf of respondents No.6 to 8.

I have personally interacted with the alleged detainee, namely, Deha Angel, who has been duly identified by her counsel Mr. Nandan Jindal, Advocate, in the Court. I have also heard learned counsel for the parties as well.

The alleged detainee has submitted that she is having love affair with Saurav Sharma-respondent No.5 since last several years and both of them are distantly related also. She wants to marry Saurav Sharma-respondent No.5, who as per her, is an unmarried boy. She has stated that she left her home voluntarily on 24.10.2022 and since then she is living with respondent No.5 out of her own free will and there is no pressure on her nor she is under any threat.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the statement made by the alleged detainee, namely, Deha Angel, this

Court is of the view that the present criminal writ deserves to be dismissed.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is hereby
dismissed, being devoid of any merit.
