1. The reply instituted to the petition, by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, discloses that the petitioner, is an accused in FIR No.0387, of 07.10.2021, registered at Police Station City Sirsa. Consequently, the participation of the accused, in the underway investigations, into FIR (supra), at the instance of the investigating officer concerned, is required, and, is also to be given to the investigating officer concerned.

2. In view of the above stated fact, the learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, does not press the petition, and, has asked for liberty to withdraw the same.

3. Liberty granted. Dismissed as withdrawn.

3. However, liberty is also reserved to the petitioner that, in case any non-bailable offences, are during the investigations, as made into the FIR (supra), hence made out against the petitioner, to access the appropriate Courts, in accordance with law, for constraining them to protect the liberty of the petitioner.
