[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.11.2021, in CWP No.23272 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.23272 of 2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider representation dated 14.10.2021 filed by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if the petitioner was found entitled and there was no impediment for the release of payment, the same be released to the petitioner as per law without any delay.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to issuance of notice to respondent Nos.3 & 4, payment as claimed in representation dated 14.10.2021 has been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
