This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR no.120 dated 05.05.2014 registered under Sections 279, 337, 427, 323 IPC at Police Station Sector 18, District Gurgaon on the basis of compromise and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.2 has submitted that the compromise has not fructified.
