Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 393 dated 2.10.2021, under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Gandhi Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Happy Sharma, complainant, alleged that on 2.10.2021 near New Shivpuri Colony Camp, Yamuna Nagar, Riyaz (petitioner) met him and demanded money for consuming drugs. On refusal he forcibly snatched Rs.4000/- from his pocket and fled away. Petitioner was arrested on 3.10.2021 and got recovered Rs.2000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of false implication. Complainant had borrowed money from the petitioner and on his demanding money back the FIR was got registered. He further submits that investigation is complete and no recovery is to be made.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the petitioner is involved in another FIR under Section 379-B IPC.

As per the allegations, injury was caused to the complainant but

there is no MLR.

Investigation is complete, challan stands presented, conclusion of trial is likely to take time and involvement of petitioner in another case in itself would not be a ground to decline bail to the petitioner, bail is granted to the petitioner on furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
