Present petition is under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 370 dated 20.10.2021 registered under Sections 406/498-A/323 and 34 IPC, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

On 24.01.2022 the following order was passed.

“The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the case bearing FIR No. 370 dated 20.10.2021, under Sections 406/498-A/323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there are general allegations levelled in the FIR and the present petition is counter blast to the petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act instituted by the petitioner. Furthermore, the parents of the petitioner have been granted anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Zorawar Singh Chauhan, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Adjourned to 14.03.2022.

Meanwhile, it is directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be admitted on interim bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer subject to the condition that he join the investigation and comply with other conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

On the instructions of SI Vikash, learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 24.01.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
