SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

It is submitted that the petitioner has been living in the house of his maternal grand father since his childhood, who had no son and died on 30.10.2017. The petitioner performed last rites and ceremonies of his maternal grand father. Respondents No.5 to 7 are using physical force and threatening the petitioner to vacate the said house. The petitioner had also filed a civil suit in this regard and vide order dated 27.04.2021, learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Ludhiana restrained respondent No.5 to interfere in the residential property of the petitioner except in due course of law. In spite of the said orders, respondents No.5 to 7 illegally entered into the house of the petitioner in the month of December, 2021, mishandled the petitioner, threatened to kill him and his family and also threatened to involve the petitioner in false criminal cases with the help of respondent

No.4. Consequently, the petitioner moved an application/representation dated 28.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arun Kaundal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the representation dated 28.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
