The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.64 dated 28.8.2019 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station, PS Women Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

By virtue of the order dated 12.1.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 12.1.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Counsel submits that parties have amicably settled the dispute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
