ASHOK KUMAR VERMA, J.

At the outset, learned counsel for the State assisted by learned counsel for the complainant points out that the petitioners have specifically mentioned in paragraph 18 of this petition that *the petitioner/accused is not a previous convict nor involved in any criminal case previously* whereas one more FIR No.87 dated 24.9.2022 has also been registered against the petitioners which fact is also mentioned in para no.7 of the order dated 12.10.2022 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda whereby anticipatory bail application of the petitioners filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.83 dated 10.9.2022 has been dismissed.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners,

while admitting the said lapse, seeks leave of this court to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for, however, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the High Court Legal Services Committee, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh.
