Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner against respondents No.5 & 6 and some other persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that previously, one Mehar Singh made a Power of Attorney in favour of father of the petitioner on 02.08.2001, who died in the year 2008 and later on, Mehar Singh did not execute any fresh Power of Attorney in favour of the petitioner and he also died. It is further submitted that respondent No.5 later on approached the petitioner that son of Mehar Singh is ready to execute the Power of Attorney in his favour, which was, in fact, executed on 07.12.2020 and thereafter, the petitioner got a power of attorney executed in favour of his Varinder

Kumar/respondent No.5. It is also submitted that now the petitioner has come to know that Power of Attorney is a fake document.

Be whatsoever, it is purely a civil dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.5, as the person, who has executed Power of Attorney i.e. son of Mehar Singh, has not come forward to lodge any complaint.

Dismissed.
