Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.73 dated 22.06.2019 under Sections 22 & 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order dated 30.09.2020, the petitioner has already been released on bail and he is regularly appearing before the trial Court. It is further submitted that a period of more than one and half year has lapsed and there is no complaint by the prosecution that either the petitioner has misused the concession or he is involved in any subsequent case. It is also submitted that out of total 16 prosecution witnesses, only 04 PWs have been examined.

Learned State counsel has filed the short affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sunam, District Sangrur and custody certificate in the Court today. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year, 03 months and 18 days.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 30.09.2020 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
