Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was relieved from the service of the respondents on 30.01.2014 though, the petitioner was to attain the age of superannuation on 30.04.2014. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Pension Payment Order has been issued after the period of four months of retirement of the petitioner and still other benefits, for which, the petitioner is entitled for in respect of the services rendered by him, have not been released to him. Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondent to grant the petitioner all the pensionary benefits forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the relief, which is being claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure P/4); a legal notice dated 18.06.2019 (Annexure P/5) and representation dated

26.10.2018 (Annexure P/7) with the respondents, which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations and legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure P/4); a legal notice dated 18.06.2019 (Annexure P/5) and representation dated 26.10.2018 (Annexure P/7) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his legal notice/representations, respondent No.2 is directed to decide representation dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure P/4); a legal notice dated 18.06.2019 (Annexure P/5) and representation dated 26.10.2018 (Annexure P/7) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a period of next four weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
