Members of the Bar are abstaining from work today.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 6 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his younger daughter-Ranjit Kaur and his son, from the hands of private respondents No.7 to 10.

On perusal of the records, let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to consider and decide the representation dated 26.10.2022 (Annexure P-3) (marked to DGP, Punjab, Chandigarh) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for his life and liberty along with his younger daughter-Ranjit Kaur and his son.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off only with a direction to respondent No.4 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a

speaking order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
