The prayer in the present petition is that the pension of the petitioner has not been fixed in accordance with law as only the period for which the CPF was deducted has been taken into account as a qualifying service and the period for which the CPF was not deducted the benefit of the said service has not been given to the petitioner which fact on the part of the respondent is contrary to the settled proposition of law. The reliance is being placed in the decision of this Court in CWP-5897-2003 decided on 09.01.2009 titled as Prem Chand Tagla and others vs. State of Haryana and others to claim the benefit.

From the pleadings, it transpires that the grievance which has been raised by the petitioner in the present petition has also been raised in the representation dated 12.04.2022, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-4, which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim raised by the petitioner in the present case or in the representation dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-4), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said representation dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-4) within a period of eight weeks by passing a speaking order from the receipt of copy of this order. In case, after the passing of the speaking order, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same be released to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
