On request, the instant matter taken in Bi-Monthly Lok Adalat,
accordingly discussed.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants
and learned counsel for respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz General Insurance
Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- (Rupees Three Lacs
and Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the
Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim
in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to
appellants to provide their Bank details to respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz
General Insurance Company within one week from today. Pursuant thereto,
Insurance Company will deposit the agreed amount in the Bank Accounts of
appellants within three weeks thereafter in proportion as already awarded by
the MACT. In case of failure to provide the Bank details by appellants, the
Insurance Company shall deposit the crossed cheques in their favour, in
proportion as already awarded by the MACT drawn on any nationalized Bank
with Lok Adalat of the High Court. In case of delay on the part of Insurance

Company, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque from the Office of Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
