DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to take action against respondent No. 6 for initiation of disciplinary proceedings against him on the basis of complaint dated 28.09.2022 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is a practicing lawyer in this Court and residing at Flat No. 332-C, Top Floor, Darpan City, Kharar. Petitioner faces a lot of hardship due to respondent No. 6, who is keeping 10-15 PG (Boys and Girls) in the adjoining flat of the petitioner i.e. 329-C, who create lot of nuisance, hurl abuses and play music at high pitch during night time. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that petitioner has submitted a detailed complaint/representation to respondent No. 2- Director General of Police, Punjab, Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh, against Respondent No. 6 on 28.10.2022 and the same has not been decided till date. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that he would be satisfied if the said representation/complaint is decided.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 4, only at this stage.

Mr. Gurdarshan Singh Sidhu, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and states that he has no objection if the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is allowed.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Director General of Police, Punjab, Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh to decide the representation/complaint of the petitioner dated 28.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) after taking into consideration all the relevants aspects of it, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
