Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.102 dated 5.7.2017 registered under Sections 307, 353, 186, 323, 427, 148, 149, 342 IPC and Section 379-B IPC & Section 3 of Damage to Public Property Act (added later on) at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 14.1.2022 passed by this Court. This fact has not been refuted by the State counsel who on instructions from ASI Inderjit Singh submitted that the petitioner is not required for any custodial interrogation.

FIR in the present case was registered on 5.7.2017 and the petitioner was not named in the said FIR and now he is not required by the police for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 14.1.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
