The petitioner-Shailender Singh Puri has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.35 dated 04.02.2021, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar and all other subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise between the parties (Annexure P-2) .

The facts of the case are that Major Sahil Gupta filed written complaint alleging that he got married with Srishti Puri (daughter of the petitioner) on 16.04.2019 at Amritsar. He came to know that his wife was having fake 10th certificates of Board of High School and Intermediate Education U.P., fake birth certificate of Municipal Corporation, Amritsar and she was doing her Bachelor of

Arts in BBK, DAV College Amritsar, on the basis of fake matriculation certificate, as well as illegal adoption of Srishti Puri. This fact when came to the notice of Shristi Puri, she threatened to involve him in a false case. A complaint was also filed to the Commissioner of Police Jalandhar. The date of birth and adoption papers were also investigated, after getting legal information the present FIR was registered.

The petitioner filed this petition for the quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. The petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. The detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the the court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar dated 29.11.2022. The statement of respondent No.2 has been recorded, where he confirmed the compromise with the petitioner. He confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion from any side and he has no objection regarding quashing of FIR.

The petitioner-Shailender Singh Puri also confirmed this fact in his separate statement. The statement of SI Waris Masih is also recorded who further confirmed that the accused is neither involved in any other case nor has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Therefore, from the report of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, it is clear that the compromise has been effected between the parties without any pressure, coercion or undue influence, which is acceptable to both the parties. In fact everything has cropped up on account of matrimonial dispute between Major Sahil Gupta and Shristi

Puri, regarding which another FIR No.0001 dated 01.01.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A was registered. They have mutually settled all their disputes. It will end all their litigation. No purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

Therefore considering these facts the petition filed by the petitioner is accepted and FIR No.35 dated 04.02.2021, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
