Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that respondents issued an advertisement dated 20.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) by which, various posts were advertised including 244 posts of Workshop Calculation and Science Instructor. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that out of the said 244 posts, 09 posts were reserved for the physically handicapped quota and 02 posts were to be filled up in the General Category for the Orthopedic Handicapped to which the petitioner belonged. Learned counsel submits that in the result declared, out of the reserved 09 posts, only 05 posts were filled and 04 posts still remain to be filled up and, therefore, these 04 posts be interchanged with the other category of the physically handicapped so as to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment on the basis of the merit already obtained.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 28.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 28.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 28.09.2022 (Annexure P-9), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
