Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.193 dated 18.08.2021 registered under Sections 379 and 411 of Indian Penal code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

On 09.11.2022, the following order was passed by this Court :-

“Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.193 dated 18.08.2021, registered under Sections 379, 411 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over a complete set of paper book of this case to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

List on 07.12.2022.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be

released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh has not disputed the aforesaid fact of joining the investigation by the petitioner and submits that his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of and the interim order dated 09.11.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute.
