By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 18 having been registered at Police Station Division C, District Amritsar, on 03.02.2021, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 465/467/468/471/420/120-B of the IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 29.12.2021 and presently her custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, the petition is allowed, with the interim order dated 29.12.2021 made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
