1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.08.2022 in CWP-17929-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-17929-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 03.08.2022, filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned AAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 14.10.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 03.08.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 14.10.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
