Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.151 dated 27.04.2021 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 506 IPC (Sections 395, 397 & 341 IPC added later on and Section 379-B IPC deleted thereon) registered at Police Station Pataudi, District Gurugram.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.01.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 17.01.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 17.01.2022 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
