Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 621 dated 25.10.2021 registered under Section 420 IPC and Sections 3, 7 and 10 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955, at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 27.01.2022 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Law and Order, Hisar, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Vide order dated 29.12.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 29.12.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.12.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
