The present petition has been filed seeking writ in the nature of habeas corpus so as to get released the detenue namely, Neetu Kamboj stated to be the wife of the petitioner, who according to the petitioner, is being detained by respondents No.4 to 6 against her will.

Notice of motion was issued.

Today, respondent-State has filed reply along with the statement made by the alleged detenue namely, Neetu Kamboj on 29.12.2021 in the presence of the Panch of the concerned village.

As per the said statement, alleged detenue, Neetu Kamboj has already broken her relationship with the petitioner and she does not want to live with him and is presently living with her parents with her own will

without there being any threat upon her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the reply filed by the respondent-State, the petitioner does not press the present petition any further the same may be disposed of having been not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to avail any other remedy available with him to seek company of his wife.
