Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Major Singh, BDPO, Moga-II submits that the term of the Administrator has been extended vide order dated 01.12.2022. Thus, the petitioner cannot be granted any relief. He would need to challenge the said order.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no explanation forthcoming for permitting the Administrator to function from 20.11.2022 to 01.12.2022.

The submissions appear to be well-founded, however, since no relief in this regard has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner is at liberty to raise all pleas in a petition challenging the order dated 01.12.2022, if so advised.

The present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
