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**AMARJOT BHATTI J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner-Jagmeet Singh has filed the instant petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0063 dated 05.10.2022, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station Women, District Bathinda.

The facts of the case are that the complainant-Harbans Kaur filed a complaint against her husband Jagmeet Singh and in-laws family alleging that her marriage took place in the year 2019, out of this wedlock she is having one son. On the birth of her son her in-laws started raising demand for more dowry and a car which her parents could not satisfy. She was threatened and illtreated in the matrimonial home. Ultimately, her father was told to take her away to the parental house. She wanted to save her married life but in-laws family is not ready to rehabilitate her. Ultimately, the present FIR has been registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 confirmed that the matter has been compromised before Mediation and Conciliation Centre and therefore, the bail application is not opposed by the counsel for respondent No.2. Even the learned counsel representing the State has not opposed the bail application. It is further pointed out that the parties will be filing petition for quashing of FIR.

Considering the aforesaid facts, the anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner be not arrested and in case he is arrested, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
