Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0228 dated 26.11.2021, under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar.

Vide order dated 03.01.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 03.01.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and submitted that the recovery is yet to be effected.

In view of the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation, interim order dated 03.01.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
