Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.162 dated 18.09.2021, under Sections 323, 34, 506 IPC and Section 03 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Panchkula.

On 30.12.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“It is submitted that the petitioner is identically situated as the coaccused Pala Ram, Amar Singh and Surat Singh son of Matu Ram, who have been afforded the concession of interim bail in the petitions filed by them, which are pending for 10.01.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl.AG., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At request, adjourned to 10.01.2022.

To be taken up along with CRM-M-53574 of 2021 and connected matters.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer and shall fully cooperate in the investigation of this case. In the event of his arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall comply with the conditions as stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ACP Panchkula Ram Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 30.12.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
