This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 77 dated 05.05.2021 under Sections 323, 451, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Machhiwara, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

A perusal of the report submitted by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samrala in pursuance of the order passed by this Court would show that in addition to respondent No. 2, one Dharam Pal is also shown as victim who has not been made party in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition after impleading all the necessary persons as party and after compromising the matter.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
