Prayer in the present petition is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 351, dated 17.08.2021, under Sections 17 & 20 of NDPS Act and Sections 25, 54, and 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Rohtak Sadar, Rohtak to attend the marriage of his niece.

In compliance of order dated 02.11.2022, a report from the Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar Rohtak, Rohtak has been received on WhatsApp from the office of learned Advocate General, Haryana, which is taken on record.

A perusal of report clearly depicts that the petitioner has son namely Sachin aged 22 years apart from his brother namely Jitender aged 36 years and Joginder aged 34 years. The factum with regard to the marriage of the niece of the petitioner has been verified and found to be correct. But in view of the afore-said report, since there are two other brothers (maternal uncles of the niece of the petitioner), who can perform the necessary

ceremonies and rituals at the time of marriage, the case for grant of interim bail to the petitioner is not made out at this stage.

Apart from above, looking into the gravity of offence and the fact that the petitions bearing CRM-M-11708-2022 and CRM-M-17831-2022 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner have already been dismissed as withdrawn by this Court, the present petition also stands dismissed being devoid of any merits.

Ordered accordingly.
