Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 9.

Vide order dated 30.12.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the official respondents were directed to examine the representation dated 22.12.2021, Anneuxre P-6, submitted by the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.12.2021, ASI Binder Singh, telephonically called the petitioners on their mobile number(s), for redressal of their grievance raised in the

representation dated 22.12.2021 and they replied that at present, they have no threat to their life and liberty and if arises in future, they would approach the police/appropriate authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute that said factual position and submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

There is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, at present and the learned counsel for the petitioners also does not want to press the present petition.

The petition is dismissed being not pressed.
