FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner-Manish, who is in custody in a case bearing FIR No.326 dated 12.03.2017 registered under Sections 302, 307, 325, 419, 420, 472, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act (Sections 325, 419, 420, 472 of the IPC has been added later on and Sections 54 and 59 of the Arms Act has been deleted later on) at Police Station Sadar, District Gurugram, has come up in this interim bail on medical grounds due to illness of his mother.

Notice of the bail application was given to the State and medical records was also called for.

Heard counsel of both the sides and perused the records.

The photostat copy of the medical record of the District Civil Hospital, Sector 10, Gurugram, shows that one, Sahab Kaur w/o Nand Kishore was examined in the OPD of the Hospital and got admitted on 03.01.2022 on account of kidney stone. It is detailed in the report of the Doctor concerned that though the patient was discharged on 05.01.2022 but no date of operation has been assigned to the patient.

As has been contended on behalf of the State, there is nothing to elicit that the patient was in precarious condition could not be controverted by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the nature of the ailment being a simplicitor kidney stone and the patient has been discharged on her own request, does not substantiates the claim of the petitioner that his mother's medical state necessitates allowing him interim bail.

There is nothing tangible evidence to support the plea for interim bail and, thus, finding no merit, the same stands dismissed.
