[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.07.2022 in CWP No.14810 of 2022 in case titled as Ram Ditta vs. PSPCL and ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.14810 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent herein to consider and decide the appeal in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the notice issued by this Court, the respondent has allowed the appeal and the petitioner has been permitted to rejoin duty on 02.12.2022, therefore, in the circumstance, he does not press the instant petition at this stage but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to represent to the competent authority for consequential benefits in view of his reinstatement.

[4] The same is not opposed to by learned counsel for the respondent.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
