ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

1. learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rajbir Singh, has opposed the bail on the ground that further details are also required from the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the complainant argues that the accused has forged documents and with those documents he has obtained a loan for Rs.5 lacs.
3. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order dated 12.01.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he has also filed an affidavit.
4. Given above, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 03.01.2022 is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called and fully cooperate with the Investigator. Failure to do so, State as well as complainant may file application for cancellation of bail. It is also clarified that the Investigator shall also make endeavours to recover the forged documents as argued by counsel for the complainant.
