[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 21.07.2022 in CWP No.15521 of 2022 in case titled as Rakesh Kumar vs. PSPCL and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals CWP No.15521 of 2022 was allowed and the respondent herein was directed to consider and decide the appeal in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the appeal filed by the petitioner having been decided by the respondent in terms of order, Annexure P/1 and the petitioner reinstated in service, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to move an application before the authorities concerned for grant of consequential relief pursuant to reinstatement.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 with the liberty as prayed for.
